The Year-Long Teaching Artist Fellowship at The Rose Theater in Omaha, Nebraska is designed as a first step for young and upcoming teaching artists/actors within the theater for young audiences industry to gain experience within the field.

- Taught theatrical curriculum-infused residencies at K-12 schools in the Omaha community & surrounding areas.
- Attended professional development sessions.
- Developed a Universal Design for Learning for The Rose Theater Alternative Curriculum Programming.
- Led a middle school after-school drama club program.
- Acted in both touring and mainstage productions.
- Completed various administrative tasks in support of the Education Director.

The Circle Theatre | Omaha, NE Teaching Artist - 2022

Spearheaded the collaboration between The Circle Theatre & Wonderfully Made (an organization dedicated to serving young women of color of varying disabilities and exceptionalities) to create an eight week-long workshop surrounding technical theatre over Zoom.

- Facilitated a virtual theatre class.
- Connected and communicated with a community organization in order to schedule programming for ages 8-15.

This position was created for a leader to practice skills in regards to outreach and community engagement.
